One of these luxuries was the home theater, which consisted of a 100-inch dropdown screen, five-channel Dolby Digital surround sound, and a subwoofer that would make the room shake. Their 2,200-square-foot home just didn't have the space needed for such a specialized room.

Since these customers did not have space for the theater, this contractor provided a unique solution to their problem by fabricating an out-

door arena.

At the push of a button on the water-resistant remote control, the 122-inch screen automatically drops down from its weatherproof enclosure, the waterproof speakers are energized, the outdoor lights automatically dim, and the projector turns on. And this can all happen while the homeowners are sitting in their hot tub!

An Exquisite Master Dressing Room

As you enter, your eyes are first drawn to a center island measuring 2'6" x 5', handcrafted in genuine cherry by our master cabinetmaker and custom-stained to match the remainder of the master suite.

The island consists of 14 drawers for undergarments, lingerie and hosiery, and four locking jewelry drawers with velvet trays. The top surface is used for folding garments and packing for those weekend getaways

Next, you can't miss the beautiful full overlay doored cabinetry in the center of the facing wall, which is home for 90 pairs of shoes and numerous purses. This helps reduce the collection of dust on interior items. It is important to mention at this point that the doors and drawer fronts throughout this area are a solid-cherry raised-panel style, blending with the warmth and character throughout this master suite, while the solid-brass Baldwin handles help to complete this picture.

The next wall contains double hanging areas for suits and shirts and a personal, closed sweater cabinet for the man of the house. Finishing this wall is an upper and lower hanging area for the woman's blouses, skirts, and suits as well.
